

BOARD OF MASON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS

1. Call to Order – The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.
2. Pledge of Allegiance – The chairperson led the flag salute.
3. Open Forum for Citizen Input – Gordon McKay asked when the by-pass would be built? Patti Stone asked the Commissioners about some recent burglaries on Landon Road and was hoping someone from the Sheriff's office could come to update their community. Bill Quigley said he didn't want the county to spend any more money on a corridor study. Someone asked if there were plans to pave Razor Road and Mel Armstrong asked for an update on the NASCAR project. Shirley Aries from Tahuya was concerned about mud coming down the Canal.
4. Ed MacLeod, our consultant for the Sandhill Park project, made a presentation to the community on the status of the project. The County is hoping it might be completed in April but we don't know due to record rainfall for December and January.
5. Commissioner Sheldon briefly discussed the Port of Tahuya situation. There is a 120 day waiting period set by a Superior Court Judge to allow time for any outstanding bills to be paid before approving the dissolution of the Port.
6. Amity Trowbridge, the new project manager for State DOT, made a brief presentation on the bypass project and the signal at SR106 and Hwy 3. They hope to have the signal functioning by Spring 2007. They anticipate the engineering review to be completed over the next year.
