Chair Sheldon called the meeting to order at 11:19 a.m.

Bill Tabor, Public Works Engineer, reported there were failures in the dikes in the Skokomish River Valley due to the flood last week. FEMA will not cover dike repairs and the Corps of Engineers will not cover new dike repairs unless they own the dikes. Rich Geiger of the Mason Conservation District is meeting with staff from NRCS, Natural Resource Conservation Service, to see if there are funding opportunities through them. They do not have a good cost estimate for the repairs and are requesting up to \$100,000 to address these failures in the Skokomish River Valley.

Cmmr. Sheldon stated the greatest amount of damage is along the Skokomish River and he believes it is appropriate to make these appropriations.

Cmmr. Gallagher asked what type of material will be used for the repairs.

Mr. Tabor answered on the waterside, it will be rock riprap. The existing dikes are constructed out of native material. It will be a combination of soil and rocks to repair and they will hire a contractor to do the work as it is beyond what staff can handle.

Cmmr. Ring Erickson /Gallagher moved and seconded to approve up to \$100,000 for dike repairs in the Skokomish River Valley from the Skokomish FloodControl Zone Fund. Motion carried unanimously. RE-aye; S-aye; G-aye.

The meeting adjourned at 11:25 a.m.
