COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS

The Mason County Courts are committed to protecting the safety and security of our community while performing our Constitutional duties. The Courts understand many people are concerned about the COVID-19 virus. We are following guidance from the Mason County Health Department to help protect peoples' health while they are engaged in the court process.

Court functions will be open during normal business hours at this time. Any changes to court hours or limiting of proceedings will be provided in further press releases. These press releases can be found on the Court websites.

Employees and court participants should follow the recommendations from the Mason County Health Department while at the Courthouses:

- Increase handwashing and use of alcohol-based sanitizer
- Respiratory hygiene and cough etiquette-cover a cough or a sneeze
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth
- Keep distance from others (more than six feet, if possible)
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces
- Remain home during a respiratory illness

Jurors who have a chronic health condition, weakened immune system, are pregnant, sick or have recently been in contact with someone who is sick, or are age 60 and older and do not wish to report for jury duty should contact the Jury Administrator at (360) 427-9670 ext. 537 to reschedule to a later date.

We ask that if you are currently experiencing a fever, cough, or difficulty breathing, please contact the Court to arrange for an accommodation before you enter the Courthouses.
