

Mason County Parks & Trails Department

Information About Our Parks

All Mason County Parks are **SMOKE & ALCOHOL FREE**.
Pets are not allowed at Mason County sport complexes (MCRA and Sandhill) or Oakland Bay Historical Park.

Parks are open from sunrise to sunset unless posted otherwise.

1. FOOTHILLS PARK (80 acres)

- Location: 241 N Foothills Park Road, Hoodspout
Directions: State Route 101, West on Lake Cushman Road (State Route 119), 1 mile to Foothills Park Road, turn right, Foothills Park is on left
Open: March – September, 9 am to dusk
Amenities: ➤ One open play field, restrooms, day use only.
Activities: ❖ Good site for family or business picnic and field games
❖ Reservations recommended



2. HARVEY RENDSLAND (JIGGS LAKE) COUNTY PARK (15 acres)

- Location: 10991 NE Belfair Tahuya Road, Tahuya
Directions: Drive toward Tahuya on Northshore Road, take a right on Belfair Tahuya Road, park is on the right after about one mile.
Open: Year around
Amenities: ➤ None – mainly hiking, open space, and access to Jiggs Lake.
Activities: ❖ Good spot to take a walk and relax. Park has not been developed.



3. JACOBY (SHORECREST) PARK (2.80 acres)

- Location: 120 E Shorecrest Parkway, Shelton
Directions: State Route 3 to Agate Road, Right on Crestview Drive, Left on Parkway Boulevard, Right on Crescent Drive
Open: Year Round
Amenities: ➤ Picnic Area
➤ Small Boat Launch
Activities: ❖ Salt Water Access to Hammersley Inlet (low tide Advisory for launch/load)
❖ NO SHELLFISH HARVEST



4. LATIMER'S LANDING BOAT LAUNCH (.59 acres) BOARDING FLOAT WAS DAMAGED IN WINTER STORM AND NO LONGER EXISTS. THE FLOAT IS SCHEDULED FOR REPLACEMENT IN FALL OF 2007. (Public can still use the boat launch, but will need to watch tides & be prepared to get their feet wet.)

- Location: 51 E Harstine Bridge Road, Shelton
Directions: State Route 3 to Pickering Road toward Harstine Island, on left before bridge
Open: Year Round
Amenities: ➤ Portable Toilet
Activities: ❖ Boat launch area to Pickering Passage
❖ Boarding Float and Dock in 2007
❖ Limited parking for vehicles with boat trailers



5. LATIMER'S LANDING OVERFLOW PARKING (2.5 acres)

- Location: 3291 Pickering Road, Shelton
Directions: State Route 3 to Pickering Road toward Harstine Island
Open: Year Round
Amenities: None
Activities: ❖ Overflow parking for Latimer's Landing Boat Launch (Approximately 700 feet from Boat Launch)

6. MASON COUNTY RECREATION AREA (MCRA) (40 acres) NO PETS ALLOWED INSIDE PARK

Location: E 2100 Johns Prairie Road, Shelton
Directions: From State Route 101, Wallace Kneeland Boulevard onto Johns Prairie Road,
1.8 miles from 4-way stop; Park is on right.
From State Route 3, right onto Johns Prairie Road; park is on left.
Open: Park Office→ Year Round; Monday – Friday 8 am – 4:30 pm
Batting Cages→ February – October; 9 am – Dark
Park Recreation Facilities→ March – October; 9 am - Dark

Amenities: ➤ Restrooms
➤ Children's Play Area
➤ Picnic Areas
➤ Covered Batting Cages (4-stations; 2 softball, 2 baseball)
➤ Two full-sized baseball fields, five baseball/softball fields
➤ Seasonal Concession (March – August)
➤ On-site Caretaker

Activities: ❖ March – June: Ball fields used by Shelton High School
(home field for all fastpitch & JV Baseball games), Oakland Bay Junior High School (home field for all games), Babe Ruth Baseball, Mason County Youth Baseball and Fastpitch Associations
❖ June – August: Co-Ed & Men's Slow-pitch Softball leagues
❖ June – August: Most weekends offer some type of tournament activity
❖ Reservations Required for Ball field Use



7. MASON COUNTY SKATE PARK (.50 acres)

Location: 110 Wallace Kneeland Boulevard, Shelton
Directions: From State Route 101 take exit to Wallace Kneeland Boulevard,
on left next to Wal-Mart Parking Lot, adjacent to Oakland Bay
Junior High School

Open: Year Round (closed during Shelton School District School hours
except youth with parent or guardian and adults.

Amenities: ➤ Portable Toilet
➤ Skate Board Ramps

Activities: ❖ Recreational Skate Boarding
NO DRINKING WATER ON SITE



8. MASON LAKE COUNTY PARK (17.36 acres)

Location: 6011 E Mason Lake Drive West, Grapeview
Directions: Take State Rt 3 to Mason Benson Road, Right on Trails Road,
Left on Mason Lake Drive W; approximately .5 mile to
Mason Lake County Park

Open: Boat Launch is open all year
Restrooms are open April - October

Amenities: ➤ Restrooms
➤ Picnic Areas
➤ Wooded Area

Activities: ❖ Boat Launch, Day Picnic
❖ Ample parking for vehicle with trailer



9. MENARD'S LANDING (.40 acres)

Location: 18931 NE North Shore Road, Tahuya
Directions: Highway 3 to Belfair, onto North Shore Road past Belfair State
Park, approximately 19 miles next to Rendsland Creek on left
Hand side of road

Open: Year Round

Amenities: ➤ Covered Gazebo
➤ Picnic Areas
➤ Sani-Can

Activities: ❖ Boat Launch for hand-carry boat/kayak or other small watercraft
❖ Limited parking on left hand side of road, additional parking in dirt lot on right just before main access gate.
❖ Next to Rendsland Creek State of Washington shellfish beach (oyster enhanced). Be sure to check Washington State Shellfish Regulations before harvesting



10. OAKLAND BAY HISTORICAL PARK (81.87 acres) NO PETS ALLOWED AT THIS PARK

- Location: 1570 E Agate Bay Road, Shelton
Directions: Highway 3 Agate Road, follow Agate Road past Pioneer School and park entrance is about one half mile past the school on the right. (across from E Jullian Road)
Open: Under Development
Amenities: ➤None – Open Space with limited paths and trails
Activities: ❖Good spot to take a walk and enjoy Melaney Creek and Oakland Bay.
Note: A master development plan is currently underway for future use of this facility.



11. PHILLIPS LAKE COUNTY PARK (.40 acres)

- Location: 50 E Phillips Lake Loop Road, Shelton
Directions: Highway 3 to Pickering Road, Right onto Phillips Lake Road, Left on Phillips Lake Loop, Park is on right
Open: Year Round – Daylight to Dusk
Amenities: ➤Small Picnic Area
Activities: ❖Passive Day Use Area
❖Adjacent to State of Washington Boat Launch with Vault Toilets



12. SANDHILL COUNTY PARK (30 acres) NO PETS ALLOWED INSIDE PARK

- Location: NE 1000 Sand Hill Road, Belfair
Directions: Highway 3 to Clifton Lane, through to State Route 300, Right on Sand Hill Road, approximately 1 mile to park Next to Sand Hill Elementary School
Open: March – October
Amenities: ➤Restrooms
➤One full-sized baseball field, six youth size baseball/softball fields
➤Seasonal Concession (March – August)
➤On-site Caretaker
Activities: ❖March-July: Ball fields are used by North Mason Little League, North Mason Fast Pitch and North Mason Pee Wee leagues
❖Reservations Required for Ball field Use



13. TRUMAN GLICK COUNTY PARK (35.46 acres)

- Location: 1291 W Ford Road, Matlock
Directions: State Route 101 to Shelton-Matlock Road, through Matlock to Deckerville Road, Right on Ford Road, ¾ of a mile, Left to Park
Open: March – September
Amenities: ➤Large Covered Shelter
➤Barbecue Grills
➤Vault Toilets
➤Wooden Arch Bridge Over Decker Creek
➤Nature Trails
Activities: ❖Good Area for Family Reunions, Group Picnics, Weddings, Receptions, Etc.
❖Access to Decker Creek
❖Shelter Reservations Highly Recommended



14. UNION BOAT LAUNCH (.16 acres)

- Location: E 5093 State Route 106, Union
Directions: State Route 106 to Union. Boat Launch is next to Hood Canal Marina
Open: Year Round
Amenities: ➤Boat Launch
➤Portable Toilet
Activities: ❖Salt Water Access to Hood Canal (low tide advisory for launch/load)
❖NO PARKING AT THIS SITE



15. UNION COUNTY PARK (1.92 acres)

- Location: 61 E Port Townsend Street, Union
Directions: Off of McReavy Road turn on 5th Street, left on Port Townsend Street, Union County Park is on left
Open: March – September
Amenities: ➤ Small Covered Shelter
➤ Restrooms
➤ Day Use Picnic Area
➤ Children's Play Area
➤ One Small Baseball/Softball Field
➤ Small Two-Hoop Basketball Court
Activities: ❖ Good Site for Group Picnics, Birthday Parties, Reunions, Etc.
❖ Ball Field Used by Youth Baseball & Fast Pitch March – June
❖ Reservations for Ball Field Required
❖ Shelter Reservations Recommended



16. WALKER PARK (5.04 acres)

- Location: 2400 SE Walker Park Road, Shelton
Directions: Olympic Highway to Arcadia Road, From Arcadia Road take Left on Walker Park Road, Park is on right
Open: March – October
Amenities: ➤ Covered Shelter
➤ Barbecue Grills
➤ Restrooms
➤ Day Use Picnic Area
➤ Children's Play Area
➤ On-Site Caretaker
Activities: ❖ Good Site for Group Picnics, Birthday Parties, Weddings, Reunions, Etc.
❖ Trail to Beach
❖ Part of Cascadia Marine Trail
❖ Reservations for Shelter Highly Recommended
❖ **NO SHELLFISH HARVEST**
