**Request for Proposal (RFP)**

Mason County Public Works is requesting proposals for the following project:

**Elfendahl Pass Road Bridge (MP 0.165) – a FEMA-funded project**

This project will replace an existing, failing 9' CMP culvert with a bridge. The proposed structure will require skewed abutments to match the stream's existing alignment. The new structure will be located within the footprint of the existing road and right of way. The new structure design will include the roadway approaches. Elfendahl Pass Road will be closed for construction – no detour structure or road will be required. Mason County Public Works will provide base mapping, including right-of-way.

Consultant services are to include geotechnical and hydraulic analysis (including downstream analysis), supporting documents required for Mason County Public Works to obtain environmental permits, bridge design, roadway approach design, preparation of specifications (PS&E), design report, an engineer's estimate, construction engineering support, bridge load ratings and scour analysis (per NBI, WSBS). Bridge Loading requirement is HL93.

Mason County Public Works encourages disadvantage, minority and women owned consultant firms to submit a proposal.

All consultants are advised that EEO Compliance Review will be conducted on this project.
