RE: Sandhill Park Dedication Ceremony

The Mason County Board of Commissioners would like to extend an invitation to the public to help Mason County celebrate the re-opening of Sandhill Park, located at NE 1000 Sandhill Road near Belfair. In 2005, Mason County Board of County Commissioners initiated a project to renovate Sandhill Park. The dedication ceremony is being scheduled to celebrate the park improvements and the reopening of the park.

Sandhill Park is a 30 acre athletic complex used primarily for baseball and softball play. There are seven fields at the park that are used by the North Mason Little League, the North Mason Pee Wees and the North Mason Girls Softball Association along with additional user organizations. Improvements to the park included renovating four of the existing seven fields, addition of two new parking areas, construction of a restroom-concession building along with the addition of other park amenities.

The dedication is scheduled for **Saturday, April 14, 10:00 a.m.** at the Sandhill Park. A short dedication ceremony will be conducted and a variety of activities are planned.
