Grant Program Benefits the Mentally Ill and Chemically Dependent

Mason County residents who are mentally ill, chemically dependent or who have co-occurring disorders will benefit from programs funded through the Sales & Use Tax program. Mason County is soliciting project proposals to fund services from the Sales & Use Tax from July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018. The total amount available is \$250,000. Projects must be eligible activities as outlined in the application packet.

Applications must be received by the county no later than 4:00 PM on Tuesday, May 23, 2017.

For the benefit of the applicants, one RFP Application Workshop will be held on Tuesday, May 2, 2017 at the Public Health Building located at 415 N. 6th St., Shelton, WA from 10:00 am to 12:00 pm and a voluntary oral presentation of proposals scheduled between 9 am and 12 noon on Tuesday, May 16, 2017.
