

RESOLUTION NO. 101 AND NOTICE OF HEARING
ON
EMERGENCY BUDGET EXTENSION

WHEREAS, unforeseen expenditures have arisen in the 1970 County Jail Budget; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of County Commissioners it is in the best interest of Mason County that provision be made for such expenditures as follows:

CURRENT EXPENSE FUND

COUNTY JAIL ----- \$3,356.00 for Category 7010 (Jail Food Budget)

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board, a budget extension in amount \$3,356.00 must be appropriated to meet these expenditures; and

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a Hearing be held at 11:00 A. M., Monday, July 13, 1970, at the office of the Board in the Courthouse at Shelton, Washington, at which time and place any taxpayer may appear and be heard for or against the granting of the above emergency budget extension.
