

RESOLUTION NO. 112

ORDER GRANTING BUDGET EXTENSION

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on August 10, 1970, declaring that unforeseen expenditures had arisen for which there was insufficient Capital Outlay Budget for General Administration for 1970; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board it is to the best interest of Mason County that such expenditures are necessary, and the following sums will be required to meet them:


