

RESOLUTION NO. 123 AND NOTICE OF HEARING  
ON  
EMERGENCY BUDGET EXTENSION

WHEREAS, unforeseen expenditures have arisen in the 1970 Budgets for the County Auditor and County Treasurer; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of County Commissioners it is in the best interest of Mason County that provision be made for such expenditures as follows:

(including sales tax & freight)
