

RESOLUTION NO. 79

WHEREAS, to date, work at the Belfair Sheriff's Office has been accomplished for the Mason County Sheriff and the Mason County Auditor by volunteer labor, which is no longer available; and

WHEREAS, it has therefore become necessary to hire a part-time Clerk to work at the Belfair Office - half time for the County Sheriff and half time for the County Auditor - and, at the time of the preparation of the 1970 Budgets, this was not anticipated;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby recognized that a nondebatable emergency exists in amount \$3,600.00, and it is HEREBY ORDERED by the Board of County Commissioners that the 1970 Mason County Auditor's and Mason County Sheriff's Budgets be extended in amount \$1,500.00 each for "Salaries", and \$300.00 each for "employees' benefits" to cover the cost of hiring the aforementioned Clerk to work for the two offices, on a 40-hour a week basis, for \$300.00 per month as salary.
