

RESOLUTION NO. 214

ORDER GRANTING EMERGENCY BUDGET EXTENSIONS

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on December 21, 1971, declaring that unforeseen expenditures had arisen for which there was insufficient budget for 1971 in the following departments; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board it is to the best interest of Mason County that such expenditures are necessary, and the following sums will be required to meet them:
