
SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION BUDGET - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reasons of conditions which could not be foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1993, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriations to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, due to federal funds for expansion of the WIC Program and fees for Hepatitis B vaccine.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners: That the **12th day of October, 1993 at the hour of 9:45 a.m.**, in the Mason County Commission Chambers at Courthouse Building I, Shelton, Washington, is hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of the supplemental appropriation to the budget for Personal Health/Nursing, in the estimated amount of \$19,082 for the above-mentioned purposes. The Clerk of the Board is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to cause notice of hearing to be published as provided by law.


