

RESOLUTION NO. 131 -99

1999 BUDGET  
SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

**WHEREAS**, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1999, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriation to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, and RCW 36.40.195 due to: **federal and state grants in Personal Health/Nursing which will be used for equipment and other operating expenses; and state grants and fees for service in Environmental Health which will be used for operating supplies, printing and binding, and equipment; and a state grant which will be used by the Fire Marshal for the costs of the Smoke Detector Program; and a federal grant for salmon recovery which will be used by Planning to hire a salmon recovery planner; and a state grant to be used by the Planning Department to fulfill requirements of the Growth Management Act.**

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners:

That the **14th day of December, 1999 at the hour of 9:50 a.m in the Mason County Commission Chambers, 411 North Fifth Street, Shelton, Washington**, is hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of the supplemental appropriation to the budget for:

Personal Health Nursing Fund	\$38,911
Environmental Health Fund	\$15,333
Current Expense	\$29,655

The Clerk of the Board is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to cause notice of such hearing to be published as provided by law.
