

**RESOLUTION NO. 60-99**  
**AMENDING CHAPTER 3.48, COMPETITIVE BIDDING,**  
**MASON COUNTY CODE**

**Section 3.48.010, Required When, Chapter 3.48, Competitive Bidding, Mason County Code is amended as follows:**

**3.48.040. REQUIRED WHEN.**

All contracts/purchases of materials, equipment, supplies, or services (i.e. printing, cleaning, etc.) where the total value will amount to more than twenty five thousand dollars (\$25,000) must be put out to competitive bidding except for purchases that are clearly and legitimately limited to a single source of supply; purchases involving special facilities or market conditions; purchases in the event of an emergency; purchases of insurance or bonds; and public works contracts in the event of an emergency.

An emergency is defined as unforeseen circumstances beyond the control of Mason County that either: (1) presents a real, immediate threat to the proper performance of essential functions; or (2) will likely result in material loss or damage to property, bodily injury, or loss of life if immediate action is not taken.
