

RESOLUTION NO. 14-10
2010 BUDGET

SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 2010, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriation to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, and RCW 36.40.195 for the following:

Reinstatement of the Long Range Planner position in the Department of Community Development for the remainder of 2010. Position to be fully funded by Stormwater Implementation Grant agreement between Mason County (Department of Public Works) and Washington State Department of Ecology (\$32,695.00) and by the Shoreline Master Program grant agreement between Washington Department of Ecology and Mason County (\$13,510.00). This budget hearing will provide an increase to 2010 Current Expense Budget of \$46,205.00.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Board of Mason County Commissioners:


