

**RESOLUTION NO. 15-10**

A Resolution authorizing the Chair of the Mason County Board of Commissioners to sign a contract with EnviroIssues to continue to provide professional assistance, to inform the public of on-going construction progress and activities and to convert on-site septic systems to the Belfair Wastewater Reclamation System.

WHEREAS, one of the most important aspects of the development of new sewer service in Belfair will be to keep the public informed of the connection of individual properties to the conveyance system and;

WHEREAS, EnviroIssues has provided public education and information services to the Country during the Belfair Wastewater Reclamation Project and;


WHEREAS, The County wishes to continue to provide information and guidance to ensure proper engineering and plumbing installation standards are met during the construction of side sewers and;

WHEREAS, The County will need to involve and engage the public during the development of monthly rates and other charges for the Belfair Sewer Utility.




