COVID-19 KNOWN AS NOVEL CORONAVIRUS:

Mason County has nineteen (19) confirmed cases of COVID-19 at the time of this release.

Positive cases are **located throughout Mason County**. Assume **everyone**, including yourself (with or without symptoms) could have COVID-19 and act accordingly.

CONFLICTING NUMBERS:

Washington State Department of Public Health reports positive test results for COVID-19 in the County where a person lives.

- Mason County has many residents who are active "snowbirds" that live outside of Mason County, even Washington State, during the winter months. They may test positive to COVID-19 in another state, but their positive test result would count in Mason County if this is their primary residential address.
- Many Mason County residents are active military and are stationed outside of Washington State and could potentially test positive to COVID-19. When this occurs, their positive COVID-19 test result would be reported as a positive test result in Mason County.
- Mason County may also have "residents" who are incarcerated outside of our county. These "residents" may test positive for COVID-19 and again, could be counted as a positive result for Mason County if their last known residential address was here.

GOVERNOR'S OFFICE:

PROCLAMATION:

- The "Stay Home, Stay Health" order is still scheduled to end on May 4, 2020.
- Proclamation 20-46, High-Risk Employees Workers' Rights gives further direction employers of how to support high risk employees as that term is described or defined in guidance issued by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.
