COVID-19 KNOWN AS NOVEL CORONAVIRUS:

Mason County has nineteen (19) confirmed cases of COVID-19 at the time of this release.

Positive cases are located throughout Mason County. Assume everyone, including yourself (with or without symptoms) could have COVID-19 and act accordingly.

RECOVERY:

Mason County's response team will continue to monitor the ongoing situation of COVID-19 and respond accordingly. While the "Stay Home, Stay Healthy" order is scheduled to last until May 4th, we have already been looking at recovery for our county including plans for when businesses, restaurants, parks, and all other activities begin to reopen.
