EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1985, it is necessary to make provision for emergency appropriations to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.140, to meet an outstanding obligation of the Superior Court to fund indigent criminal costs and jury fees for 1985.
