

RESOLUTION NO. 170-85
 RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO ESTABLISH SPEED LIMITS
 MASON COUNTY ROADS

WHEREAS, the speed limits on county roads in Mason County, Washington, were fixed by Resolution on April 20, 1981, as 50 miles per hour, except certain roads as otherwise posted; and,

WHEREAS, existing conditions on the following roads in Mason County warrant speed limit changes.
