COUNTY ROAD PROJECT NO. 1043

WHEREAS, on Mason County Road No. 31110, known locally as the (Hole-In-The-Wall) Hartstene Island South Road, and more specifically located in Sec. 36 T 20 N., R. 2W, M.P. 4.27 to M.P. 5.08, work defined as "construction" in the BARS Manual, Page II-63, et seq, is determined to be necessary and proper, and

WHEREAS, this project is hereby made a part of the officially adopted County Annual Road Program pursuant to RCW 36.81.130 and assigned # 16 thereon.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that it is their intention to under item # 16 MINOR CONSTRUCTION to widen and improve sight distances at selected location between the aboce M.P.'s.

and that said work is to be performed by Day Labor in accordance with the (day labor/contract) Washington State Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction as adopted by Mason County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above described County Road Project is necessary and proper, and the estimated costs of said project are herewith set out as follows:
