SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1985, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriations to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, due to a grant from Washington State Department of Agriculture for construction of restroom facility at the fairgrounds.
