1993 BUDGET

SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION BUDGET - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1993, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriations to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, due to unbudgeted beginning fund balance (cash carry over) for an Environmental Health Specialist for a four month period.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners:


